1 limber going towards ABIGNY-au-BAF along road in L 33 bad
5.30 pm. Much individual movement seen on road in R 28 b going
both ways.

6.40 pm. 12 Over our lines but were driven back by 3 of ours.
6.45 pm. 16 over our lines at 6000 ft
7.15 pm. 1 at 4000 ft. over our lines,
8.25 pm. 1 at 5000 ft. flying S.W. from DOUAI.
8.40 pm. 1 at 1000 ft. flying N.E. to DOUAI.
10.35 pm. 1 at 3000 ft. over P 18 and 24
12.30 pm. Hostile machines were bombing SAUDEMONT and
Artillery positions in RECOUSS.

From 6 am. to 6 pm. September 18th, 1918.

Attitude of Enemy. Normal.

Artillery. (Ours)
Active against enemy rear area and approaches.
(Hostile)
100 rounds 4.2 and 5.9 in P 18 c and d, Q 31ⁿ and c
and P 36 b and d, Escourt St. Quentin, Q 21 a and Q 13.

Machine guns.
Both very active against aircraft.

Movement. (Transport.)
10.45 am. 2 G.S.wagons cover d with 2 extra horses seen
entering FRESSAIN from road in G 32 b 5 9.
12.10 pm. 1 G.S.Wagon moving S.E. on road in approx. G 23 c
(Troops.)
11.00 am. A large party of men were seen on the DOUAI-
CABRAI Rd. at R 28. They divided into two parties

75 men, 1st party of approx. 75 men left the road at R 28 d 8.7. and travelled east.

60 men, 2nd party followed (after a few minutes interval) in disorder and left road at R 28 d 8.7. Both parties disappeared on the other side of ridge.

11.45 am. 25 men left DOUAI-CAMBRAI Rd. at R 28 d 8.7 and disappeared.

10.55 am. 3 men seen going along road in L 33 c towards BUGNICOURT.

10.57 am. 3 men seen going along road in L 32 b towards BUGNICOURT.

10.55 am. 1 man on bicycle riding on dry weather track towards main road L 33 d.

12.45 pm. 1 man looking towards our line through glasses from R 22 a 90.05.

12.45 pm. 5 men mounted going north on road at R 3 b 9.9

1.30 pm. 3 men mounted road into FRESSAIN, coming from FICHAIN.

2.00 pm. 8 men walking south on road in R 3 b.

AIRCRAFT.

[Ours] Hostile A.A. and M.Gs. very active against our planes.
[Hostile]

3.30 pm. 2 machines 4000 ft. going east.

3.40 pm. 2 machines 8000 ft. over our rear area.

3.45 pm. 2 machines over his front line, attacked by one of ours. The 2 hostile machines went east.

11.00 am. Hostile balloons up at 97⁰ TB

11.10 am. do 123⁰ TB

11.10 am. do 55⁰ BB

12.20 pm. 89⁰ TB

1.25 pm. 4 guns observed firing from R 4 c.
