Introduction

En raison des nouvelles techniques de combat, les unités de cavalerie n'ont pas participé de façon très active dans leurs rôles traditionnels de combat et de protection des autres armes. Elles ont cependant rendu un service très important en tant qu'observateurs et messagers.

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Canadian Cavalry Brigade

Historique

Mise sur pied à Salisbury Plain le 2 février 1915 sous le commandement du Colonel J. E. B. Suly.

Autorisation publiée dans *Salisbury Plain Order* du 30 janvier 1915.

Composée du *Royal Canadian Horse Artillery*, *Royal Canadian Dragoon*, *Lord Strathcona's Horse (RC)* et *2nd King Edward's Horse*.

Concentrée à Mansfield Park, Mansfield, Sussex.

Arrive en France, sans le *Royal Canadian Horse Artillery (RCHA)* le 6 mai 1915 comme une unité à pied, connue sous le nom de *Suly's Detachment*.

Devient *Canadian Cavalry Brigade* le 22 juillet 1915.

Redevient une unité équine dans le *Canadian Corps* en septembre 1915.

Suly's Force est formée le 3 octobre 1915, composée du *Canadian Cavalry Brigade* et *1st Canadian Mounted Rifles Brigade*.

Suly's Force est démantelée le 9 octobre 1915. Réassemblée le 22 novembre 1915, cette fois-ci composée de *Canadian Cavalry Brigade*, *1st* et *2nd Canadian Mounted Rifles Brigades*, cesse d'exister le 10 décembre 1915.

Canadian Cavalry Brigade est transféré à *1st Indian Cavalry Division* le 26 janvier 1916.

Fort Garry Horse remplace *2nd King Edward's Horse* dans la *Canadian Cavalry Brigade* le 25 février 1916.

Retourne en Angleterre le 16 avril 1919.

Arrive au Canada le 29 mai 1919.
